All jewellery must be removed.

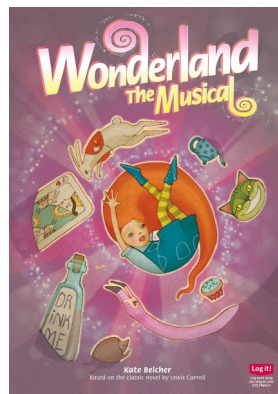


### Production!
